



NOTICE OF RACE

NYC MERMAID LEINSTERS CHAMPIONSHIP 2010

The Mermaid Leinster Championship will take place in the National Yacht Club Saturday Saturday 2nd and Sunday 3rd October. There will be two back-to-back races on each day i.e. 4 races in total.

Rules

This event shall be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS 2009-2012), the prescriptions of the Irish Sailing Association (ISA), the Class rules and the Sailing Instructions.

All those taking part in this event do so at their own risk and responsibility. The organisers shall not be responsible for the seaworthiness of a yacht whose entry is accepted or for the sufficiency or adequacy of its equipment. The organisers shall not be responsible or liable for any injury to persons or damage to property either ashore or afloat which may result from participation or intended participation in this event.

Entries

Entries shall be made on the attached entry form and returned to the National Yacht Club, Dun Laoghaire, Co. Dublin. For entries received by Thursday 30th September the early entry fee applies.

Mermaid early entry fee for Leinsters only €35 (4 races) – late fee €45

Mermaid early entry fee for Frostbite series only €80 (10 races) – late fee €90

Mermaid early entry fee for Frostbite & Leinters combined €90 (12 races) – late fee €100

Moorings/Berths/Dry Sailing Facilities

The NYC lift-out for Cruisers is 16th October and NYC boats may be asked to move during the Frostbite to facilitate this.

Schedule of races (Leinsters only):

Sunday 3 rd October	11.10	2 races

Subsequent races on each day will be sailed as soon as possible after completion of the previous race. If there have been races postponed, a third race may be run as required.

Discards

There will be 1 discard if four races are sailed.
If less than four races are sailed there will be no discard.

Sailing Instructions and Prizes

Sailing Instructions will be as for the Frostbite series and will be available prior to the first race at the race office of the National Yacht Club and on the National Yacht Club website the week prior to the first race. Prizes for the event will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place if there are ten boats or more.

Prizes will be presented Sunday 3rd October after racing.
